Federal Poverty Guidelines

The following maximum income levels, which are based on 125% of the latest revisions of the Federal Poverty Guidelines determines by the Department of Health and Human Services and approved by the Legal Service Corporation, should be used to determine client eligibility effective May 1, 2022.

| Size of Family | 2022 Monthly Income | 2022 Yearly Income |
|-----------------------|----------------------------|---------------------------|
| 1 | 1,416 | 16,988 |
| 2 | 1,907 | 22,888 |
| 3 | 2,399 | 28,788 |
| 4 | 2,891 | 34,688 |
| 5 | 3,382 | 40,588 |
| 6 | 3,874 | 46,488 |
| 7 | 4,366 | 52,388 |
| 8 | 4,857 | 58,288 |

For family units with more than eight (8) members, add \$5,900/year or \$492/month for each additional member in the family.

These guidelines are based on gross income.
