We provide civil legal assistance—which does not include criminal or traffic matters—to low-income individuals and older Coloradans throughout the state.

THIS MONTH'S HIGHLIGHT Licensed Legal Paraprofessionals

Aracely Gutierrez, a paralegal of nearly 10 years who has worked for 7 years at Colorado Legal Services, helped lead the organization in developing its LLP program. She achieved her LLP licensure, and in May became the first practicing legal aid LLP in the state. Gutierrez said she is passionate about helping people in her home state, and particularly on the Western Slope where resources are limited.

TOP CASES OPENED



HOUSING

Colorado Legal Services opened 391 housing-related cases in July. These include eviction issues, landlord/tenant disputes, and other matters.



FAMILY AND SAFETY

Colorado Legal Services opened 213 family-related cases in July. These include domestic violence issues, divorce, and other matters.



CONSUMERS

Colorado Legal Services opened 156 consumer-related cases in July. These include helping people with bankruptcy, debt collection issues, and other matters.
